Highway Highlights 3/27/2024

1. The Blue Collar Staff have ended the winter shift schedule and are on regular hours.
2. Our crews have been starting the spring cleanup, including road sweeping and shoulder repairs. We done a significant amount of ditching and drainage improvements and we have continued with tree removals for various projects.
3. Advocacy event was successful with the bus from Madison, Oneida, and Herkimer Counties being filled to capacity and over 700 members made the trip to Albany from both Town and County Associations on March 6. To date both the Senate and Assembly have increased CHIPS funding and other local program funding in their budget proposals a total of \$650-\$700M.
4. We have completed some of the preliminary site work for the communication huts and have scheduled a start date for April 1st to begin concrete work, with anticipated completion of around the end of April.
5. We completed a couple more tours of the Facility at Brown Road. One for Chenango County and another for a town. We also are working on a plan to provide an additional bathroom at the Wampsville shop and potential relocation of the Highway Administration offices to the Social Services building.
6. Spring safety training has been scheduled for April 16th, 2024.
