1. Draft RFP Release Date: May 24, 2023

The draft Request for Proposals to Lease & operate Solid Waste Facilities is ready to go and will open May 24, 2023.

2. Outreach Efforts for Draft RFP / Next Steps

S. Field presented a public communications plan for the release of the draft RFP. S. Field and K. Welch have updated the FAQ page for the website and handouts for the transfer stations, along with a press release. A. Miller will work with them to set up public informational sessions explaining why the department is pursuing this option.

3. Regulatory Updates

A. Miller provided a brief overview of upcoming regulatory changes relating to leachate management and biosolids. In addition, the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation has requested public comments on their NYS Solid Waste Management Plan. These regulatory updates will have significant impacts on how landfills are run.

Other Business:

The recent DEC inspection went well with cover on the landfill and

litter management. Cell 10 construction continues. Storm water plans are being updated with the new regulations.
