The meeting was called to order by Chairman Rex Vosburg at 10:42 a.m. in the Chambers.

Minutes:

The minutes of the February 25, 2026 meeting were unanimously approved on the motion of Vice-Chairwoman Michelle Kinville and second of Board Chairman James Cunningham.

District Attorney:

Chief Assistant District Attorney Sam Rodgers provided the following updates:

- Down a part-time attorney who is out on medical leave for about six weeks.
- Looking into getting electric monitoring for domestic violence to help the victims of those crimes be able to stay in their house. Law enforcement would be alerted if the person convicted of the crime approached the house that they aren't supposed to in relation to an order of protection that is in effect.

Sheriff's Office:

Undersheriff James Quatrone provided the following updates:

- Had another ICE contact on March 4.

- The State Commission of Corrections came to visit the jail about a week and a half ago to inspect and see if ICE detainees were treated the same as all other inmates. They were happy with what they saw and said they would be visiting quarterly. They called last week and made an appointment to do another visit on April 20.
- Hired a deputy who will be in the academy at the end of the month. Still have one vacancy and looks like we could have three more this summer and next year we could have seven vacancies.
- Everything looks good for the move to Cazenovia. Went there last week for a meeting. Were told four to six months for blue prints and next summer or fall until we can move in.

Emergency Management:

Director of Emergency Management Dan Degear provided the following updates:

- Our EM Associate Christa and our former intern Josie presented to the school superintendents on Continuity of Operations Planning and the importance of it.
- Next month some of us from the office are going to attend a couple day training at the Family Assistance Center. This is a regional effort with us, Onondaga and Oswego Counties.
- Tomorrow I am meeting with a radio systems consultant regarding the Hoffman windmill project regarding the Carey Hill tower and how it will negatively impact the Town of Sullivan.
- At last month's meeting, we talked to you about the EMS CME program, an affiliation program for continuing medical education which is a credit that our providers need. Some fire departments and other agencies are looking to affiliate with our program. We have been working with the Attorney's Office and Compliance. We will charge anyone that wants to join us \$15 per year and will receive a \$300 credit from the State.
- Would like to set up site visits with the Committee members.

Director of EMS Jenna Illingworth provided the following updates:

- On Friday, May 22nd, the Regional EMS Council is hosting an annual recognition and awards ceremony from 6pm – 10pm at Vernon Downs. Would like County representation there as well.
- Back in November of last year, we held a training for peer support for first responders and had 13 Madison County employees attend. We have put together a peer support and critical incident debriefing team made up of 14 Madison County employees who are volunteering their time. This is a collaborative effort for law enforcement, EMS, firefighters and 911 dispatchers.

Chairman Rex Vosburg presented the following resolutions to the Committee:

Authorizing the Chairman to Enter into an Inter-Municipal Agreement for Police Tactical Team Cooperation

The Committee unanimously approved the resolution on the motion of Kinville and second of Corbin.

Discussion: Resolution 25-299 was previously approved in October and sent out for signatures from Syracuse but the agreement was misplaced by Syracuse. They came back with some changes. The Committee approved the agreement subject to our attorneys reviewing and approving those changes.

The Committee unanimously approved the resolution on the motion of Kinville and second of Cunningham.
